Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 8 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, in a mound of stone, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. for sec. 1, with brass cap mkd.

Land, high and rolling mesa. Soil, sandy and rocky clay loam with rocky subsoil. Undergrowth, medium growth of sage and scattering bunch grass.

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Retracement of the E. Bdy. of T. 46 N., R. 33 E.  
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From the Std. cor. of T. 46 N., Rs. 33 and 34 E., which is a cottonwood post in decayed state, lying on a mound of earth, with a few scribe marks visible.
