N. 0° 36' E., on a true line, on the E. Bdy. of sec. 1. Over rolling land.

- 2.70 Dry wash, course SW. Asc. SW. slope 130 ft.
 20.00 Top of low spur, projects SW. Desc. NW. slope 20 ft.
 33.59 True point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. for sec. 6, hereinafter determined.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. for sec. 6, with brass cap mkd.
