43.90 Dry wash, course NW. Asc. W. slope 320 ft.

80.00 Intersect the E. Bdy. of Twp., at a point, N. $0^{\circ} 12'$ E., 6.17 chs. dist. from the Std. cor. of T. 46 N., R. 35 E., hereinbefore described.
