## General Description, T. 46 N., R. 34 E.

The main divide between Kings River and Quinn River traverses the township in a northwesterly and southeasterly direction through sections 4, 9, 10, all and 12, and in a southwesterly and northeasterly direction through sections 13, 24, 25, 26, 34 and 35.

The land on the east slope of the divide is a high rolling mesa, at an approximate elevation of 6500 ft. The land on the west slope drops abruptly to an elevation of approximately 4500 ft. in the western part of the township. This land is generally, rough, broken and mountainous, and is very rocky, many of the higher
