

Survey of the W. Bdy. of T. 47 N., R. 34 E.

Chains.

An aspen, 6 ins. in diam., bears S. 45° E., 20 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 6 BT

41.00 Leave dense aspen, bears NE. and W.

45.00 Point of spur, projects E.

47.10 Channel of creek, course E.

48.50 Creek with running water, 2 lks. wide, 1 in. deep, course S. 60° E. Asc. SE. slope 40 ft.

51.91 A northing of 40.00 chs. from the cor. of secs. 1 and 12. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. for sec. 11, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of the cor.

Asc. SE. slope 560 ft.

80.66 Intersect the S. Bdy. of T. 48 N., R. 34 E., at a point, East, 3.00 chs. dist. from the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. for sec. 31. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., 14 ins. in the ground, to bed rock, in a mound of stone, for the closing cor. of T. 47 N., Rs. 33 and 34 E., with brass cap mkd.

Deposit a volcanic stone, 10 x 8 x 4 ins., with cross marked (x), at base of post.

Land, rough and broken mountainous. Soil on crests of ridges and spurs shallow and rocky with outcroppings of volcanic rock; soil along creeks a rich black loam from 6 inches to 30 inches in depth. Undergrowth, medium growth of sage and scattering grass. Timber; willows and aspen along creeks and lower slopes.

Asc. broken and rocky SE. slope of canyon 140 ft.
