- 79.86 The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.
Land, slightly rolling. Soil, sandy and rocky clay loam.
Undergrowth, medium growth of sage, scattering shadscale

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- N. 0° 01' W., on a random line, bet. secs. 1 and 2.

Desc. along E. slope 200 ft. over rolling mesa land.
