

## Survey of the subdivisions of T. 44 N., R. 35 E.

Chains.

Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, W.  
of the cor.

Desc. along SE. slope 80 ft.

64.90 Dry wash, course SE. Asc. gradual NE. slope.

73.35 The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.

Land, rolling and rolling mountainous. Soil, sandy and  
rocky clay loam. Undergrowth, medium growth of sage  
and scattering shadscale. Poor grazing.

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From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, on the S. Bdy.  
of the township, which is an iron post, 2 ins. in  
diam., 24 ins. above ground, firmly set in a mound  
of stone, with mound of stone W. of cor.,

N.  $0^{\circ} 03'$  W., on a true line, bet. secs. 32 and 33.

Desc. gradual E. slope over high rolling mesa land.

12.40 Dry wash, course S.  $30^{\circ}$  E. for about 15.00 chs., thence  
SE. Asc. gradual SW. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins.  
in the ground, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap  
mkd.

Desc. broken NW. slope 650 ft.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 27 ins.  
in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and  
33, with brass cap mkd.
