Chains.	S. $89^{\circ} 47'$ W., on a true line, on the S. Bdy. of sec. 31. Desc. SW. slope 690 ft. over broken mountainous land.
28.20	Dry wash, course NW. Asc. NE. slope 60 ft.
34.40	Top of spur, projects NW. Desc. W. slope 150 ft.
39.86	Intersect the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., hereinbefore described. From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., S. $89^{\circ} 45'$ W. Desc. W. slope 60 ft.
41.80	Dry wash, course NW. Asc. NE. slope 20 ft.
45.60	Top of low spur, projects NW.

Start	From the cor. of T. 43 N., Rs. 38 and 39 E., West, on a true line, on the S. Bdy. of sec. 36. Desc. W. slope 20 ft. over rough mountainous land.
3.90	Creek, course N. 20° E., running water, 1 lk. wide, 1 in. deep. Asc. NE. slope 70 ft.
11.40	Slope changes to NW. Desc. 30 ft.
14.10	Creek, course NE.; running water, 4 lks. wide, 2 ins. deep. Asc. along S. slope 70 ft.
17.10	Trail, Lamance Ranger Station to Rebel Creek Ranger Station, bears N. and S. Asc. general S. slope 140 ft.
