

Survey of the S. Bdy. of T. 43 N., R. 38 E.

Chains. Desc. NW. slope 150 ft.

44.40 Rock Creek, course SW.; running water, 3 lks. wide, 3 ins. deep. Asc. along S. slope 70 ft.

53.90 Slope changes to SW. Desc. 60 ft.

63.40 Dry wash, course S. Desc. along S. slope 170 ft.

75.80 Rock Creek, course N. 70° W. Asc. NE. slope 20 ft.

77.82 Intersect the W. Bdy. of T. 43 N., R. 38 E., subsequently determined, at a point, N. 0° 24' E., 556 lks. dist., from the old cor. of Ts. 42 and 43 N., Rs. 37 and 38 E., hereinafter described. At the point of intersection set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of Ts. 42 and 43 N., R. 38 E., with brass cap mkd.

Deposit a granite stone, 12 x 8 x 5 ins., with cross marked (x), at base of post. No other accessories available.

Land, rough mountainous. Soil, sandy, gravelly and rocky clay. Undergrowth, medium growth of sage and grass and scattering buckbrush. Aspen and willows along the bottom of creek.

Retracement of the W. Bdy. of T. 43 N., R. 38 E.

From the old cor. of Ts. 42 and 43 N., Rs. 37 and 38 E., which is a decayed willow post, 2 ins. in diam., 2 ft. long, with scribe marks faintly discernible, set in a mound of stone and earth,

North, on retracement, setting temporary points at 40.00 and 80.00 chs. and making diligent search for old cors. No old cors. were found until a point,

480.60 Fall 336 lks. W. of the old cor. of Ts. 43 and 44 N., R. 37 E., which is a granite stone, 12 x 8 x 6 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked with 6 grooves on N., S. and W. faces, with mound of stone W. of cor.
