## Chains.

61.80 Slope changes to S. Desc. 110 ft.

80.06 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.

Land, rough mountainous. Soil, gravelly and rocky and sandy clay with outcroppings of granite, quartzite and slate. Undergrowth, medium growth of sage, good growth of grass and scattering buckbrush. A few scattering clumps of aspen and willows along bottom of washes.

N. 0° 02' W., on a true line, bet. secs. 4 and 5.

Asc. S. slope 180 ft. over rough mountainous land.

6.10 Top of ridge, bears E. and W. Desc. NW. slope 610 ft.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins.
