Chains

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 18 ins. in the ground to solid rock, in a mound of stone, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd



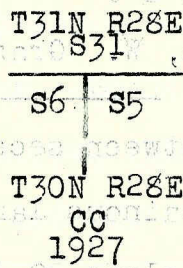
At base of post deposit a mkd(X) granite stone, 2x4x8 ins.

44.70 Head of ravine, drains N. 15° W. Asc. SW. slope 80 ft. to

47.25 Spur, projects N. 15° W.

47.46 Intersect the Sixth Standard Parallel North, .78 chs. W. of the standard cor. of secs. 31 and 32, and at point of intersection

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. dia., 12 ins. in the ground to solid rock, in a mound of stone, for the closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap mkd



At base of post deposit a mkd(X) granite stone, 2x5x7 ins.

No suitable trees within limits.

Land, rough mountainous. Soil, rocky.

Timber, scattering juniper. Undergrowth, sage.

General drainage, SW. Grazing, poor.
