

Survey of portion of N. boundary T. 29 N., R. 29 E.

Land rolling. Soil, gravelly and rocky.
 Timber, none. Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale.
 General drainage, SE. Grazing, poor.

General Description

The land traversed by the lines of survey is level to Rolling in character.

No timber is to be found and about the only growing plant is a dense covering of sagebrush.

There are no settlers and no water.

No mineral in paying quantities have been discovered.
