General Description.

The greater part of this township is located in a chain of low lying mountains, having a maximum elevation of 6100 ft. and a minimum elevation of about 4400 ft. above sea level. The mountainous sections of the township are very rough, with rock slides and occasional outcroppings of granite. The ravines and washes have, almost without exception, steep, rocky sides, and gravelly, boulder-strewn, narrow bottoms. The fall in all canyons is great.

Sections 1, 2, 26, 27, 34, 35, and 36 range from level to rolling in character, and sections 3, 10, 11, 23, and 24 are rolling mountainous to mountainous, while the remainder of the township is rough mountainous.

Scattering stands of juniper timber- scrubby in nature- are found in the higher elevations.

The predominant types of undergrowth are, sagebrush, shadscale, and buckbrush, which thickly cover the township
