GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

The greater part of this township is located in a chain of high rugged mountains, known as the Fish Creek Range. The summit of the range is the divide between the watersheds of the Reese River and Jersey Valleys. The mountainous sections of the township are very rough, being thickly covered with fragmentary granite and outcroppings of basalt.
