Chains. At base of post, deposit a granite stone, 11 x 7 x 5 ins., marked with cross (x). Pits impracticable and no other accessories available.

42.00 Desc. rocky NW. slope 140 ft.

50.40 Dry wash, drains W. Asc. S. slope 100 ft.

53.00 Slope changes to NW. Desc. 290 ft.

69.20 Dry wash, drains W. Asc. along SW. slope 190 ft.

80.00 On sloping granite ledge mark a cross (x) over which, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., in a mound of stone, 7 ft. base, 36 ins. high, for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with brass cap mkd.

9.00 Top of spur, projects W. Desc. NW. slope 30 ft.

16.50 Slope changes to SW. Asc. 20 ft.

20.00 Top of spur, projects W. Desc. abrupt NW. slope 380 ft.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 16 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 20 ins. high, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
