

## Survey of a portion of the subdivisions of T.28 N., R.41 E.

Chains. From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, on the S. Bdy. of the township, which is an iron post, 3 ins. in diam., firmly set, properly marked and witnessed, as described in the field notes of T. 27 N., R. 41 E., N. 0° 02' W., bet. secs. 33 and 34.

Asc. SE. slope 40 ft. over rolling mountainous land.

4.70 Top of spur, projects NE. Desc. NW. slope 120 ft.

15.80 Dry wash, drains NE. Asc. SE. slope 50 ft.

22.10 Top of spur, projects NE. Desc. NW. slope 40 ft.

26.30 Dry wash, drains NE. Asc. SE. slope 40 ft.

30.30 Top of spur, projects E. Desc. N. slope 50 ft.

33.30 Dry wash, drains E. Asc. S. slope 60 ft.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, W. of the cor.

43.50 Top of spur, projects NE. Desc. NW. slope 130 ft.

68.80 Dry wash, drains NE. Asc. SE. slope 50 ft.

80.00 On crest of low spur, projecting NE., set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34, with brass cap mkd.
