

Survey of a portion of the subdivisions of T.28 N., R.41 E.

Chains.

Timber, scattering to medium growth of scrub juniper.

West, on a true line, bet. secs. 30 and 31.

Asc. NE. slope 80 ft. over broken mountainous land.

12.50 Top of spur, projects NW. Desc. SW. slope 250 ft.

22.30 Dry wash, drains NW. Asc. NE. slope 140 ft.

27.40 Top of spur, projects NW. Desc. W. slope 150 ft.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins.

in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of the cor.

Desc. NW. slope 210 ft.

54.10 Dry wash, drains NW. Asc. E. slope 80 ft.

65.00 Top of low spur, projects NW. Desc. gradual N. slope.

78.56 Intersect the W. Bdy. of the township, at a point, North, 4.31 chs. distant from the cor. of secs. 25 and 36, which is an iron post, 2 ins. in diam., firmly set and properly marked and witnessed, as described in the field notes of T. 28 N., R. 40 E.

At the point of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 30 and 31, with brass cap mkd.
