General Description.

The area surveyed in this township is suitable only for grazing purposes. The greater portion of the land is rolling or broken mountainous; is covered with a scattering to medium growth of scrub juniper; a scattering to medium growth of shadscale, with some sage along the bottom of washes. The land has been overstocked and affords only fair grazing at the present time.
