

Independent Resurvey of the E. Bdy. of T. 23 N., R. 46 E.

NOTE: In the independent resurvey of the east boundary of T. 23 N., R. 46 E., diligent search was made, along each mile, at a northing of 40.00 and 80.00 chs. from the old corner of Ts. 22 and 23 N., Rs. 46 and 47 E. No old corners were found along this line.

Alongside the old cor. of Ts. 22 and 23 N., Rs. 46 and 47 E., hereinbefore described, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of Ts. 22 and 23 N., R. 47 E., with brass cap mkd.

From the closing cor. of Ts. 22 and 23 N., R. 46 E., North, on a true line, on the E. Bdy. of sec. 36.

Asc. gradual SE. slope over nearly level land.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. for sec. 36, with brass cap mkd.
