

Survey of the N. Bdy. of T. 23 N., R. 46 E.

Chains.	Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of the cor. Land: E. half, broken mountainous; W. half, rolling. Soil, light sandy, gravelly and rocky clay. Undergrowth sage, shadscale and fair growth of grass. Timber, a few scattering juniper.
	N. $89^{\circ} 58'$ W., on a true line, bet. secs. 6 and 31. Asc. along SE. slope 210 ft. over slightly rolling land.
