## Chains

80.00 On a gradual S. slope,  
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. dia., 26 ins. in  
the ground, for cor. of secs. 35 and 36, with brass  
cap marked

A cedar limb, 6 ins. diam., bears N.  $64\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 148 lks.  
dist., marked T23N R49E S36 BT

A pinon, 10 ins. diam., bears N.  $70^{\circ}$  W., 172 lks.  
dist., marked T23N R49E S35 BT

Land, rolling mountainous land with general W. to SW. ex-  
posure and drainage.

Soil, gravelly and clay loam, mixed with rock; 3 rd rate.

Timber, scattered to dense cedar and pinon.

Undergrowth, medium dense sagebrush.

East, on S. bdy. sec. 36.

Over rolling mountainous land, through medium timber and  
undergrowth; gradually desc. along S. slope.

4.20 Small draw, near head, 5 ft. below cor., drains S.

9.30 Cross head of draw, 15 ft. below cor., drains SW.; asc.  
W. slope, 50 ft.

13.70 Spur, at point 1 ch. S. of saddle, projects S.; desc.  
steep E. slope, 50 ft.

17.60 Draw, at head, drains S.  $10^{\circ}$  E.; asc. SW. slope, 100 ft.

25.60 Spur, projects S.  $20^{\circ}$  W. for about 10 chs. to end.  
Descend 75 ft. over E. slope.

29.85 Draw, drains S.; ascend 35 ft.

33.00 Top of low rise bet. draws, bears S. 5 chs. to end.

34.60 Small draw, 25 ft. below rise, drains S: for 4 chs. to  
junction, thence SW.; ascend SW. slope, 75 ft. to cor.

40.00 On a gradual SW. slope,  
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 26 ins. in  
the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked
