Chains

Timber, cedar and pinon.

Undergrowth, sagebrush.

North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over rolling and hilly land, through dense sagebrush;
desc. low rolling land facing NE., 75 ft. to

16.70 A main draw, drains NW.; asc. steep, rocky SW. slope.

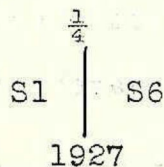
17.50 Enter medium dense timber, bears NW. and SE.

19.00 Enter volcanic slide rock, bears NE. and SW.

24.00 Leave slide rock, bears NE. and SW.

33.00 Top of ascent on W. slope of high hill, 190 ft. above
draw, bears E. 5 chs. dist. to top, and slopes off
abruptly to W.; desc. along W. slope, leaving nearly
all timber, bears NE. and SW.

40.00 On steep NW. slope, 55 ft. below top of ascent,
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 26 ins. in
the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked



from which

A pinon, 5 ins. diam., bears S. 65° E., 80 lks.
dist., marked only BT (scrubby)

A cedar, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 57° W., 317 lks.
dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S1 BT

Descend along rolling NW. and W. slopes, 185 ft.

66.75 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, in bottom of swale,
drains NW.; enter bench land with gentle W. exposure,
and enter scattered timber.

67.75 Old road, bears N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.

71.00 Top of slight rise on bench, 20 ft. above wash, bears
E. and W.

72.60 Recross same road, bears NE. and S. 20° W.

80.00 On gentle SW. exposure on bench,
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. dia., 26 ins. in
ground, for cor. of Ts. 23 and 23 $\frac{1}{2}$ N., Rs. 49 and 50 E.,
