

Subdivision of T. 23 $\frac{1}{2}$  N., R. 49 E.

## Chains

- 59.90 Bottom of a large draw, 50 lks. wide, drains S.70°E., from NW.; asc. steep, rocky S. slope, 200 ft. to spur.
- 65.70 Top of outcrop 40 ft. high, facing S., extends E. 1 ch. and W. 3 chs. to end.
- 69.50 Top of rocky spur, projects S.60°E., from NW.; desc. rocky N. and NE. slopes, 115 ft.
- 81.18 Intersect N. bdy. of tp., S.89°30' E., 2.87 chs. dist. from the cor. of secs. 34 and 35 on S. bdy. T.24 N., R. 49 E., heretofore described. At point of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. dia., 26 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2, with brass cap marked

from which

- A pinon, 24, ins.diam., bears S.16°E., 370 lks. dist., marked T23 $\frac{1}{2}$ N R49E S1 CC BT
- A pinon, 14 ins.diam., bears S.88°W., 203 lks. dist., marked T23 $\frac{1}{2}$ N R49E S2 CC BT

Corner stands on a rocky E. slope.

Land, rolling with a general easterly to northeasterly exposure and drainage.

Soil, gravelly clay and rocky; 3rd and 4th rates.

Timber, scattered cedar and pinon.

Undergrowth, dense sagebrush.

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From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 2 and 3 on S. bdy. of tp., an iron post, 2 ins. dia., recently established under this group and described in survey of T.23 N., R.49 E.

Thence

N. 0°01' W., bet. secs. 2 and 3.

Over rolling land facing generally NE., through dense sagebrush; asc. rolling SE. slope, 50 ft.

- 12.00 Top of rolling spur, projects NE.; desc. N. and NW. slopes.
