

Survey of a portion of the subdivisions of T.24 N., R.49 E.

Chains.

21.90 Dry wash, drains E. Asc. S. slope 150 ft.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 12 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, in a mound of stone 22 ins. high, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

A juniper, 6 ins. in diam., bears S. $8\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 223 lks. distant, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S2 BT

A juniper, 4 ins. in diam., bears S. $38-3/4^{\circ}$ W., 146 lks. distant, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S3 BT

Desc. NE. slope 20 ft.

43.90 Dry wash, drains E. Asc. S. slope 30 ft.

52.00 Slope changes to N. Desc. 70 ft.

57.50 Dry wash, drains E. Asc. SW. slope 300 ft.

76.25 Intersect the N. Bdy. of the township, at a point, east, 1.80 chs. distant from the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, which is an iron post, 2 ins. in diam., firmly set, properly marked and witnessed, as described in the field notes of T. 25 N., R. 49 E. I destroy all markings and accessories pertaining to the S. township and mark the post on the south T24N R49E S3.

At the point of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap mkd.

A juniper, 8 ins. in diam., bears S. $73\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 52 lks. distant, marked CC T24N R49E S3 BT
