

DEPENDENT RESURVEY NORTH BOUNDARY OF T. 19 N., R. 39 E.

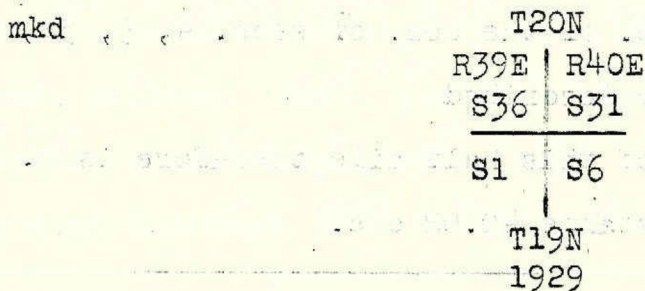
Chains

80.14 Fall 6 lks. S. of the cor. of Ts. 19 and 20 N., Rs. 38 and 39 E. The bearing of this half mile therefore is S. 89° 48' W., and the distance 40.11 chs.

True lines

The original cor. of Ts. 19 and 20 N., Rs. 39 and 40 E., is a wooden post, firmly set in a large mound of stone, with markings partially obliterated.

Alongside original cor. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. dia., 8 ins. in the ground to solid rock, in a mound of stone, for the cor. of Ts. 19 and 20 N., Rs. 39 and 40 E., with brass cap



At base of post deposit a mkd(X) granite stone, 8x7x3 ins. Thence

From the cor. of Ts. 19 and 20 N., Rs. 39 and 40 E. S. 89° 50' W., along S. bdy. sec. 36, T. 20 N., R. 39 E. Over rough mountainous land through scattering timber Asc. rocky SE. slope 25 ft. to

3.40 Ridge, bears N. 15° E. and S. 60° W.

Desc. rocky NW. slope 55 ft. to

10.60 Head of ravine, drains N.

Asc. general NE. slope

18.70 Spur, projects N.

Desc. NW. slope 110 ft. to

30.55 Ravine, drains N. 20° E.

Asc. general rocky SE. slope 85 ft. to
