

Retracement of the N. one-half mile bet. secs. 22 and 23,

T. 31 N., R. 43 E.

Chains. From the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 22 and 23, which is an iron post, 1 in. in diam., firmly set, and properly marked and witnessed with a mound of stone W. of cor., North, on retracement, bet. secs. 22 and 23.

40.15 Fall 1.7 lks. W. of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 22 and 23, which is an iron post, 2 ins. in diam., firmly set, and properly marked, and witnessed with a mound of stone S. of the cor.

The course of this  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile is N.  $0^{\circ} 01' 24''$  E., and the dist. is 40.15. chs.

Retracement of the E. one-half mile on the N. Bdy. of sec. 22, T. 31 N., R. 43 E.

From the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. for sec. 22, which is an iron post, 1 in. in diam., firmly set, and properly marked, and witnessed with a mound of stone S., East, on retracement, on the N. Bdy of sec. 22.

40.00 Fall 16 lks. N. of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 22 and 23, hereinbefore described.

The course of this  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile is S.  $89^{\circ} 46'$  E. and the dist. is 40.00 chs.

Survey of the Gold Flake Lode.

In the center of the location monument for the SW. cor. of the Gold Flake Lode, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 36 ins. in the ground, on rocky S. slope, for cor. No. 3 of the Gold Flake Lode, with brass cap marked.
