Deposit a pint glass bottle at base of post.

Land, rolling hills with a SE. exposure and drainage.

Soil, coarse rocky and sandy loam; 3rd rate.

No timber.

Undergrowth, medium dense sagebrush from 1 to 3 ft.

high; medium growth of grass and weeds.

Good grazing land.

From the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, on E. bdy. of Tp., which is an iron post, 3 ins. diam., extending 12 ins. above the ground, with brass cap marked

Cor. is witnessed by a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft high to the W.

Thence

S. 89° 47' W., bet. secs. 24 and 25.

Abrupt descent over rolling hills, through medium dense undergrowth.

2.00 Draw, 55 ft. below sec. cor., drains S. 15° E.; ascend gentle E. slope.

27.50 Ridge, 100 ft. above draw, brs. N. and S.; descend gentle W. slope.

39.79 Proportionate point, on gentle W. slope 25 ft. below ridge.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the ground on solid rock and 10 ins. in a mound of stone for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap marked
