

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF SUBDIVISION OF T. 36 N., R. 48 E.

Chains

Undergrowth, a medium dense sagebrush from 1 to 3 ft. high; medium growth of grass and weeds.
Good grazing land.

From the standard cor. of secs. 33 and 34, on S. bdy. of Tp., which is an iron post, 3 ins. diam., extending 12 ins. above the ground with brass cap marked

Cor. is witnessed by pits, and a mound of earth.

N. 0° 56' W., bet. secs. 33 and 34.

Ascend gentle S. slope over rolling hills, through medium dense undergrowth.

9.70 Ridge, 15 ft. above sec. cor., brs. NE. and SW.; thence descend along gentle NE. slope.

40.03 $\frac{1}{2}$ Proportionate point, on gentle NE. slope, 100 ft. below ridge.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of cor.

74.80 Draw, 80 ft. below $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., drains W., from the SE.; ascend S. slope.

77.20 Spur, 25 ft. above draw, projects N. 80° W.; descend N. slope.

80.07 Proportionate point, on gentle N. slope, 10 ft. below spur.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34, with brass cap marked
