9.70	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap marked
40.03 $\frac{1}{2}$	Ridge, 15 ft. above sec. cor., brs. NE. and SW.; thence descend along gentle NE. slope.
	Proportionate point, on gentle NE. slope, 100 ft. below ridge.
74.80	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap marked
77.20	Spur, 25 ft. above draw, projects N. 80°W.; descend N. slope.
80.07	Proportionate point, on gentle N. slope, 10 ft. below spur.
