

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF SOUTH BOUNDARY OF T. 37 N., R. 48 E.

Chains

Land, E. half mile nearly level bottom of draw; W. half
rolling with S. exposure.

Soil, sandy clay loam and gravelly; 1st and 2nd rate.

No timber.

Undergrowth, dense growth of sagebrush 2 to 5 ft. high
and rabbit brush on E. half mile; medium dense sage-

brush, 1 to 3 ft. high on W. half mile. Medium

growth of grass and weeds on slope to draw.

Good grazing land.

N. 89° 29' W., bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Over rolling land, through medium dense undergrowth.

6.90 Commence descent into draw, brs. N. and S.

11.75 Wash, 15 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, 40 ft. below sec. cor.,
drains S.; thence over rolling land.

15.00 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, drains S. 20° E.; ascend
over rolling E. slope.

25.70 Low rise, 50 ft. above wash, brs. N. and S.

28.50 Shallow draw, drains SE.; ascend.

35.00 Top of ascent, 30 ft. above draw, brs. N. and S.; thence
over rolling land.

39.53 The original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., which is a willow stake, $2\frac{1}{2}$
ft. long, 1 in. sq., lying on old mound of earth.

The stake is badly decayed and no marks are legible.

In center of mound of earth.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in
the ground with brass cap marked

S 31

S 6

1930

Set old stake alongside of post, and raise a mound of
stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high N. of cor.

Cor. stands on gentle E. slope.

Thence

N. 89° 56' W., with continuous measurement.
