

DEPENDENT RESURVEY SOUTH BOUNDARY OF T. 38 N., R. 48 E.

Chains

Rs. 48 and 49 E., as points of control, the bearing of the S. bdy. T. 38 N., R. 48 E., bet. the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32 and the restored position for cor. of Ts. 37 and 38 N., Rs. 48 and 49 E., therefore is S. 87° 56'E., and the proportionate length of each mile is 78.64 chs.; the bearing of the line bet. secs. 31 and 36, E. bdy. of T. 38 N., R. 48 E., therefore is N. 1° 50'W., and the distance is 78.54 chs.; the bearing of the S. bdy. of T. 38 N., R. 49 E., bet. the restored position for cor. of Ts. 37 and 38 N., Rs. 48 and 49 E., and the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, therefore is S. 89° 26'E., and the proportionate distance is 156.11 chs.; and the bearing of the E. bdy. T. 37 N., R. 48 E., therefore is S. 0° 37'E., and the proportionate length of each mile is 78.54½ chs.

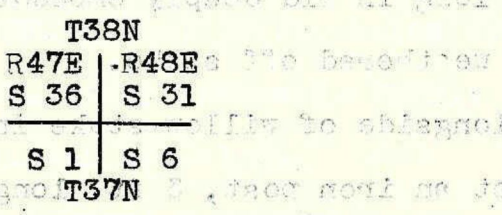

True Lines.

The original cor. of Ts. 37 and 38 N., Rs. 47 and 48 E., is a greatly decayed hewed willow stake, 1½ in. sq., lying on an old deeply embedded mound of stone. All traces of marks have decayed off stake.

In center of old mound of stone.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground for cor. of Ts. 37 and 38 N., Rs. 47 and 48 E., with brass cap marked



Set old willow stake alongside of iron post, and raise
