GENERAL DESCRIPTION, T. 38 N., R. 48 E.

This township contains all varieties of land from small

gently rolling valleys and low hills to high, rough and rocky mountains. With the exception of a small area in the south central portion of the township which drains south toward Antelope Draw, the drainage is chiefly north and west to Willow Creek. The mountainous portion is of a malpais or volcanic formation; the slopes rise abruptly from the surrounding terrain which is very noticeable on the northwestern part of the township and are very rocky with numerous ledges and outcroppings.

The soil of the mountainous land is quite rocky, of volcanic formation with a clay and gravel subsoil, while in the low rolling hills and valleys it is a deep clay loam mixed with gravel and in places the surface is strewn with rock.

There is no timber in this township.
