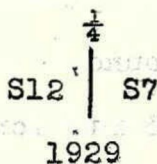


DEPENDENT RESURVEY WEST BOUNDARY OF T.39 N., R.48 E.

Chains

bedded mound of stone, and marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face.  
 Alongside cor.,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 27 ins. in  
 the ground with brass cap marked



Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, W. of cor.

Thence

N.0°13'E., with continuous measurement.

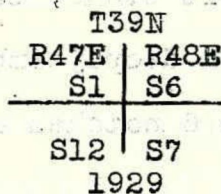
42.70 Draw, drains NW.; gradually ascend.

69.55 Low ridge spur, projects NW.; gradually descend over  
 gentle N. slope 45 ft. to

80.46 The original cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12, which is a  
 trap rock, 10x5x4 ins., firmly set in the ground and  
 deeply embedded mound of stone, and marked with 1 notch  
 on N. and 5 notches on S. edge.

Alongside cor.,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 28 ins. in  
 the ground with brass cap marked



Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, rolling with general W. exposure and drainage.

Soil, gravelly and sandy clay loam; 2nd. and 3rd. rates.

No timber.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and native grasses.

N.0°14'E., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Gradually descend N. slope over rolling land through

sagebrush undergrowth.

18.50 Bottom of Rock Creek (dry), 60 ft. below sec. cor.,  
 drains SW.; gradually ascend gentle S. exposure.

40.41 Intersect the center of an old mound of earth and stone
