The course of this mile is S. 0° 16' E. and the distance is 80.13 chs.

S. 0° 14' E. on the 79th mile, with continuous line from the 72nd mile post.

80.51 Fall 28 lks. W. of the 79th mile post, hereinafter described.

The course of this mile is S. 0° 18' E. and the distance is 80.51 chs.

Dependent Resurvey of the Nevada-California State Line
between the 79th and 72nd Mile Posts.
(original surveys executed by A.W. Von Schmidt in 1872)

At the exact corner point of the 79th mile post, which is a juniper post, 5 ins. square and 5 ft. long, marked NEV on E. face, CAL on W. face and 79M on N. face, firmly, set in a mound of stone, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., 9 ins. in the ground to solid rock, in a mound of stone 3 ft. base 27 ins. high, for the 79th mile post on the Nevada-California State Line, with brass cap mkd.



Reset original juniper post alongside.

N. 0° 18' W. on a true line, on the 78th mile of the Nevada-California State Line.

Desc. gradual NE. slope over rolling mountainous land.
