

Dependent Resurvey of the Nevada-California State Line

Between the 79th and 72nd Mile Posts

Chains. Desc. 80 ft. along broken E. slope of ridge to the 72nd mile post.

66.99 Intersect the standard closing cor. of Ts. 35 1/2 and 36 N., R. 18 E., which is an iron post 3 ins. in diam., firmly set and properly marked and witnessed, as described in the field notes of T. 36 N., R. 18 E. I change the markings on this corner, on the S.E. to refer to fractional T. 35 1/2 N., R. 18 E.

80.44 Intersect the 72nd mile post, described in the field notes of T. 36 N., R. 18 E. Land: rolling and mountainous. Soil: a heavy clay containing much rock. Undergrowth: sage, buckbrush and deer browse. Good growth of grass. Timber: juniper and mahogany.

Survey of a portion of the S. Bdy. of T. 35 N., R. 18 E. Alongside the original cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, Ts. 34 and 35 N., R. 18 E., which is a volcanic stone, 20 x 8 x 6 ins., marked with 4 grooves on E. face and 2 grooves on W. face, set in a mound of stone, set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 20 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, in a mound of stone 16 ins. high, for the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, with brass cap mkd.
