

Department Survey of the Nevada-California State Line

Survey of a portion of the S. Bdy. of T. 35 N., R. 18 E.

Chains and Putnam surveys to the Nevada-California State Line,

I destroy.

47.30 Top of rim 20 ft. high on crest of spur, projecting N. and facing W. Desc. broken and rocky W. slope 170 ft. through scattering juniper and mahogany, to dry wash.

53.84 A westing of 40.00 chs. from the closing cor. of Ts. 34 and 35 N., R. 18 E. on the Nevada-California State Line, subsequently determined. Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the 1/4 sec. cor. for the S. Bdy. of sec. 32, only, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of the cor.

64.00 E. edge of rolling flat. Continue very gradual descent.

73.80 Shallow dry wash, drains N. Gradual ascent of E. slope 40 ft.

93.84 Intersect the Nevada-California State line at a point, S. 0° 18' E., 33.45 chs. distant from the 78th mile post of the Nevada-California State Line, hereinbefore described. At the point of intersection, set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of Ts. 34 and 35 N., R. 18 E., with brass cap mkd.
