Survey of a portion of the N. Bdy. of T. 35 N., R. 18 E.

Chains. in diam., 12 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, in a mound of stone 24 ins. high, for the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, with brass cap mkd.

Land: rolling mountainous.
Soil: heavy adobe containing much rock.
Undergrowth: sage and buckbrush. Good growth of grass.
Timber: scattering to medium growth of juniper and scattering pinon pine.

Survey of a portion of the N. Bdy. of T. 35 N., R. 18 E.

From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, West, on a true line, bet. secs. 5 and 32. Asc. abrupt, rocky E. slope 70 ft. over broken and mountainous land, through scattering juniper. Top of rocky ridge, bears N. and S. Desc. rocky NW. slope 430 ft. to dry wash. Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 20 ins. in the ground, for the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 32, only, with brass cap mkd.

At base of post deposit a volcanic stone 12 x 8 x 5 ins. marked with cross (x). Dry wash, drains SW. Desc. 30 ft. An easting of 40.00 chs. from the closing cor. of secs. 5 and 32, subsequently determined, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 5 only, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of the cor. of sec. 5. Desc. SW. slope 90 ft.
