

Survey of a portion of the N. Bdy. of T. 35 N., R. 18 E.

- Chains.
- 63.70 Dry wash in bottom of Express canyon, drains N. 20° W. Asc. NE. slope 270 ft.
  - 92.70 E. rim of canyon; continue gradual ascent.
  - 94.58 Intersect the Nevada-California State Line, at a point, S. 0° 11' E., 37.18 chs. distant from the 72nd mile post, described in the field notes of T. 36 N., R. 18 E. At the point of intersection, set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., 20 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, in a mound of stone 16 ins. high, for the closing cor. of Ts. 35 and 35½ N., R. 18 E., with brass cap mkd.

From the cor. of Ts. 35 and 35½ N., Rs. 18 and 19 E.,

North on a true line, bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Gradual descent over rolling and rocky mesa.

- 20.63 Intersect the fourth standard parallel north, at a point, East, 15.45 chs. distant, from the standard cor. of T. 36 N., Rs. 18 and 19 E., which is an iron post, 3 ins. in diam., firmly set and properly marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 36 N., R. 18 E. At the point of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., 18 ins. in the ground, to solid rock and 18 ins. in a mound of stone, for the closing cor. of Fractional T. 35½ N., Rs. 18 and 19 E., with brass cap mkd.
