

Survey of the E. Bdy. of fractional T. 35 $\frac{1}{2}$ N., R. 18 E.

Chains.

At base of post deposit a volcanic stone 14 x 10 x 5 ins. marked with cross (x).

Land: rolling mesa.

Soil: heavy adobe containing much rock and thickly strewn with surface rock of volcanic origin.

Undergrowth: sage and buckbrush. Good growth of grass.

Timber: very scattering juniper. *3/20*

Survey of the subdivisions of fractional T. 35 $\frac{1}{2}$ N., R. 18 E.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 on the S. Bdy. of the township,

N. 0° 01' W. bet. fractional sections 35 and 36.

Asc. SE. slope 40 ft. over rocky mesa.

15.00 Top of low ridge, bears S. 80° E. and N. 80° W.

Desc. gradually.

22.09 Intersect the seventh standard parallel north, at a point, East, 15.26 chs. distant from the standard corner of secs. 35 and 36, which is an iron post 2 ins. in diam., firmly set and properly marked and witnessed, as described in the field notes of T. 36 N., R. 18 E. At the point of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of fractional sections 35 and 36, with brass cap mkd.
