

Method of procedure, T. 33 N., R. 19 E.

With the exception of secs. 3 and 4, where the usual order of procedure was reversed to avoid unnecessary lotting, the remaining unsurveyed lines were projected from south to north and from east to west, throwing the fractional measurements against the north and west boundaries and the old work.

82.52 Fall 39 lks. W. of the cor. of secs. 25 and 36, hereinafter described.

The course of the N. one-half mile is N.  $0^{\circ} 29'$  W. and the distance is 41.34 chs.
