Chains.

Random line.

From the cor. of Ts. 28 and 29 N., Rs. 22 and 23 E., described in the field notes of T. 28 N., R. 23 E. West on a random line, on the S. Bdy. of the township, setting temporary corners at 40.00 and 80.00 chs.
 119.56 Fall 14 lks. N. of the closing cor. of secs. 2 and 35, Ts. 28 and 29 N., R. 22 E., on the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation line.

The course of this line is S. 89° 56' W. and the distance is 119.56 chs.

True line.

From the cor. of Ts. 28 and 29 N., Rs. 22 and 23 E., described in the field notes of T. 28 N., R. 23 E., S. 89° 56' W. on a true line, on the S. Bdy. of the township, bet. secs. 1 and 36. Gradual ascent over slightly rolling land, over general N. slope.

- 31.90 Shallow wash, drains N.
- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked
