

Survey of a portion of the S. Bdy. of T. 29 N., R. 22 E.

Chains. marked with cross (x).  
 Land; slightly rolling.  
 Soil; medium clay loam of alkaline content and containing some rock.  
 Undergrowth; shadscale and sage.  
 Scant growth of grass.

S. 89° 56' W. on a true line, bet. secs. 2 and 35.

Gradual ascent of NE. slope over slightly rolling land.

33.50 Shallow wash, drains NE.

39.56 Intersect the closing cor. of secs. 2 and 35, Ts. 28 and 29 N., R. 22 E., on the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation line, which is an iron post 3 ins. in diam., firmly set and properly marked and witnessed, as described in the field notes of T. 28 N., R. 22 E. This corner changed by additional markings to refer to the east sections, as follows:

Random line.

From the closing cor. of secs. 19 and 24, on the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation line, on the W. Bdy. of the township, which is an iron post, 1 in. in diam., marked and witnessed, as described in the field notes of the survey of the portion of T. 29 N., R. 22 E., within the Indian Reservation, North on a random line, on the W. Bdy. of the township, setting temporary points at 40.00 and 80.00 chs.
