

Completion of subdivisions, T. 29 N., R. 22 E.

Chains.

Raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of the cor.

From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. spring bears N. $46^{\circ} 31'$ W.
Desc. 245 ft. over NW. slope.

54.50 Dry wash, drains NE. Asc. 10 ft. over rolling SE. slope.

57.00 Spring, bears N. $70^{\circ} 30'$ W.

59.30 Road, bears NE. and SW. Asc. 70 ft. over rolling SE. slope.

80.01 Intersect the N. Bdy. of township, at a point, West, 2.13 chs. distant, from the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34,

and 35, which is an iron post, 3 ins. in diam., firmly set and properly marked and witnessed, as described in the field notes of T. 30 N., R. 22 E. The markings on this corner changed to refer to secs. 34 and 35 only.

At the point of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap marked
