Chains.	Land; rolling mountainous. Soil; rocky and gravelly clay. Undergrowth; medium growth of sage. Fair growth of grass.
	S. 0° 02' E. on a true line, bet. secs. 21 and 22. Asc. 45 ft. over NE. slope, over rolling mountainous land.
5.00	Top of ridge, bears NW. and SE. Desc. 180 ft. over S. slope.
19.40	Dry wash, drains SE. Asc. 14 ft. over NE. slope.
25.50	Desc. 10 ft. over rolling SE. slope.
40.00	Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

	Raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of the cor.
40.50	Top of low spur, slopes SE. Desc. 170 ft. over SW. slope.
51.60	Dry channel of Little Rattlesnake Canyon, drains SE. Asc. 30 ft. over N. slope.
56.00	Desc. 5 ft. over S. slope.
57.90	Dry wash, drains E. Asc. 170 ft. over N. slope.
75.90	Top of spur, slopes E. Desc. 30 ft. over rolling SE. slope.
77.28	Intersect the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation line, at a point, N. 84° 57' W., 99 lks. distant, from the closing cor. of secs. 21 and 22, which is an iron post, 1 in. in diam., firmly set and properly marked and witnessed, as described in the field notes of T. 29 N., R. 22 E. within the Reservation Boundary. At the point of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 21 and 22, with brass cap marked
