Chains.

Land; mountainous; numerous outcroppings.
 Soil; rocky and gravelly, coarse, decomposed granite.
 Undergrowth; medium growth of sage.
 Fair growth of grass.

N. 0° 04' W. bet. secs. 5 and 6.

Desc. 165 ft. over NW. slope, over mountainous land.

6.10 Dry wash, drains E.; small spring in bottom of wash,
 20 lks. E. of line. Asc. abrupt S. slope 420 ft.

25.50 Crest of spur-ridge, projects S. 70° E. for about 20.00
 chs.; top of peak bears N. 85° 55' W.; vertical angle
 plus 18° 10'. Desc. 110 ft. over NE. slope.

31.50 Dry wash, drains N. 80° E. Continue descent 30 ft.

34.70 Top of spur, projects N. 70° E. for about 15.00 chs.,
 thence NE. Desc. 130 ft. over NE. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in
 the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

41.80 Dry channel of fork of Rodeo Creek, drains NE.

Asc. 160 ft. over rolling SE. slope.

63.00 Desc. 145 ft. over rolling NE. slope.

76.00 Asc. 25 ft. over rolling SE. slope.

80.01 Intersect the N. Bdy. of the township, at a point,
 West, 1.82 chs. distant, from the cor. of secs. 5, 6,
 31, and 32, which is an iron post 3 ins. in diam.,
 marked and witnessed, as described in the field notes
 of T. 30 N., R. 22 E. The markings on this corner
 changed to refer to secs. 31 and 32 only.

At the point of intersection, set an iron post 3 ft.
 long, 2 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the
 closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap marked
