

General Description.

The resurveyed portion of this township lies on high broken slopes of a main ridge or divide which bears in a general northerly direction thru the west range of sections. Mountainous, rough spurs project from this divide in a general easterly direction to the eastern edge of the east range of sections where low rolling and hilly slopes are encountered.

The old mining camp of Gemville is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 20. Many of the old buildings are now in ruins and no one lives at the old camp. On the west slope of Natchez Pass in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 30, there are several small frame structures and a mill building. At the time of the survey, the mill building and the mining machinery contained therein, were being torn down and removed.

There are indications of mineral thruout the entire resurveyed area. Many of the old producing properties have been abandoned for the past number of years but there are many recent indications of renewed activity on a small scale. The entire area has been extensively prospected.

The nearest postoffice and railroad station is at Mill City, Nevada about fifteen miles westward.
