40.50	Low spur, projects N.10°W.; descend NW. exposure 200 ft.
56.70	Draw, drains NW.; ascend NE. slope, with evaded sec. cor.
60.15	Spur, projects NW.; descend NW. and W. slopes 200 ft. to sec. cor. S.04.8 base N. exposed, bears N.W. 06.18
80.00	On gentle NW. slope at base of mountain, bears NE. and SW.
-81.00	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31, and 32, with brass cap marked
86.70	Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor. Land, rolling mountains; general NW. exposure and drainage.
90.00	Soil, shallow gravelly loam and rocky of granite formation; 3rd. and 4th. rates.
90.00	Timber, a few pinon on east portion of mile.
90.00	Undergrowth, shadscale, and native grasses.
90.00	To wash, near middle of draw, lined West, bet. secs. 6 and 31.
90.00	Descend over rolling bench land facing NW., through short undergrowth.
39.30	Wash, 30 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, 160 ft. below sec. cor., drains N.10°W.
40.00	On gentle N. slope.
40.00	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 16 ins. in the ground on solid rock and in a mound of stone for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked
50.00	Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.
63.80	Rim, bears N.30°W. and S.30°E.; descend short W. slope to bottom of wide draw.
66.30	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains N.
77.90	Main wash in draw, 15 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains N.
