	Descend abrupt N. and NE. slopes broken by ledges, outcrops and sliderock, over high, rugged mountainous land, through dense mahogany and scattered juniper and pinon timber and scattered undergrowth.													
10.00	Leave dense mahogany timber and enter dense juniper and pinon timber, bears E. and W.													
21.50	Descend over large outcropping facing N. and NE.
