

Dependent Resurvey of the E. Bdy. of T. 13 N., R. 61 E.

Chains Deposit a granite stone; 6x5x4 ins., with cross marked (x), at base of post. No other accessories available.

49.40 Dry wash, course SW. Asc. gradually along SW. slope.

80.62 Intersect the old cor. of Ts. 13 and 14 N., Rs. 61 and 62 E., hereinbefore described. Alongside, set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground for the cor. of Ts. 13 and 14 N., Rs. 61 and 62 E., with brass cap mkd.

Deposit a granite stone, 6x4x4 ins., with cross marked (x), at base of post. No other accessories available.

Land, nearly level. Soil, light, gravelly clay. Undergrowth, medium growth of shadscale, scattering growth of sage and scant growth of grass. No timber.

Retracement of a portion of the W. Bdy. of T. 13 N., R. 61 E.

From the old cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, on the W. Bdy. of the township, which is a granite stone, 36x12x2 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, marked with 1 notch on S. face and 5 notches on N. face, North, on retracement, setting temporary points at 40.00 and 80.00 chs. and making diligent search for old corners. No old corners were found until a point

405.70 Fall 213 lks. W. of the old cor. of Ts. 13 and 14 N., Rs. 60 and 61 E., which is a juniper post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. square, marked with 6 notches on each face, set in a mound of stone.

The course of this line is N. 0° 18' E. and the proportionate length of each mile is 81.14 chs.
