

INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE EIGHTH STANDARD PARALLEL NORTH, THROUGH R. 22 E.

Chains

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Land, rolling and mountainous with a general northeasterly exposure and drainage.
Soil, shallow, loose, sand and clay loam, mixed with decomposed limestone and lava; 3rd rate.
Undergrowth, dense shadscale, sage, and rabbit brush.
No timber.

Fair grazing.

West, along the S. bdy. sec. 31.

Descend gradually over rolling mountainous land through dense undergrowth.

10.00 Ravine, 30 ft. below cor., drains N. 70° E.

24.00 Edge of bench land, bears N. 70° E. and S. 70° W.

40.00 On rolling land, 80 ft. above ravine.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked.

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high N. of cor.

68.00 Wash, drains N. 70° E.

84.53 Intersect the E. bdy. of sec. 1, T. 40 N., R. 21 E., South, 140 lks. dist. from the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. sec. 1, heretofore described.

At point of intersection:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for standard closing cor. T. 41 N., R. 22 E., with brass cap marked.
